Section 1.4 LEVEL OF STANDARDS. The performance requirements as specified in this Ordinance are minimum standards and address general floodplain management requirements. Specific projects may warrant additional requirements, based upon site specific conditions and standard engineering practice, not specifically anticipated, stated or cited within this Ordinance. The Flood Control District and the Floodplain Administrator have the authority to establish standards and/or policies as necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance. Said standards and/or policies are to be in keeping with standard engineering practice, unless otherwise approved by the Board of Directors. All drainage design standards, state standards, river and basin management plans, or other land use plans previously approved by the Board of Supervisors, Flood Control District Board of Directors or Floodplain Administrator, and considered current, are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.
